INTRODUCTION

Welcome to our very franglais 2018-19 Jacques Prevert After School Clubs brochure, comprising:

- p3 School Calendar for 2018/19*
- p4 Clubs Weekly Timetable for 2018/19*
- p5-25 Club Information Sheets for the 21 different clubs on offer*

There have been some big changes since last year. Some clubs are closing (streetdance), new clubs are opening (yoga, tennis), others are evolving (English) and many have shifted location and/or days. **In addition the booking & payment system is changing. We're embracing technology and going on line.**

There are two types of clubs. Those that are independently run (black clubs in list opposite) and those that are run by the APEEF (red clubs in list opposite). Independent clubs take their own bookings and payments. See club information sheets for details on how and when you can book places in these clubs. Note that some are available to book from now.

For APEEF run clubs, we're introducing a new on-line booking and payment system. **This system will go live at the end of August and we will email all parents in July/August advising on how and when you can access the online booking system.** Session and semester fees will be confirmed when the system goes live - an indication of fees is given in this brochure. Payment in full of the semester will be required to secure the reservation. (Refunds will be possible if you cancel before the second week of term.) There will be no paper booking forms and no 'Club Registration Day' on the first Friday of term. **Most clubs will be first-come first-served.** A few clubs are allowing priority booking for children enrolled in the clubs this year to ensure continuity of teaching. Please refer to the club info sheets.

The clubs will operate on a semester basis - ie. you sign your child up for an entire semester. Semester 1: September-February. Semester 2: February-July. For most clubs, Semester 1 starts the week of 10th September 2018. However Arts Plastique, Danse and Playball will not start until the week of 17th September 2018, to allow MS children time to settle in at school. Semester 2 starts the week of 25th February 2019.

Lastly, please note that the school is closed to non-staff from 5.30pm This includes the secure area for scooters and bikes. For those in clubs off-site, you will not be able to collect scooters/bikes from the school after 5.30pm.

The after school clubs are run entirely by volunteer parents. If you'd like to get involved in any way, please do contact us as volunteers, help and ideas are always welcome!

DESCRIPTION DU CLUB

Whether or not your child grows up to be the next Zuckerberg, programming is a highly useful skill to learn. It teaches vital problem-solving, creativity, and communication skills. Game Code Kids will introduce your children to the basic fundamentals of coding, and teach them how to solve complex puzzles through fun games, projects and different computational activities.

The club follows a mixture of a preset curriculum set out at the beginning of term, which follows the UK's Key Stage 2 syllabus - designing and writing programs to achieve specific goals as well as understanding computer networks and using logic to find and correct mistakes in algorithms. Children will also get a chance to make their independent coding projects during free time too.

What is coding?

Coding is what makes it possible to create computer software, apps and websites. Browsers, OS devices, apps on phones/tablets, Facebook, and websites – are all made with code.

What are the computer languages used in class?

The club uses a combination of Blockly and Javascript. Blockly is a language made of visual blocks with hidden code inside and Javascript is currently the most widely used programming language.
